بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ
الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ وَكَفَى وَسَلَّمَ عَلَى عِبَادِهِ الَّذِينَ اصْطَفَى أَمَّا بَعْدُ،

Sayyidina Anas bin Malik Radhiyallaahu Anhu said that Rasulullah Sallallaahu Alayhi wa Sallam said:

الدُّعَاءُ مُخُّ الْعِبَادَةِ،

Du'aa is the essence of ibaadah (worship). (Tirmidhi)

Du'aa holds a very sacred position in Deen. We are instructed to always make Du'aa and ask from Allah Ta'aala. Du'aa after a Salaah is an accepted Du'aa, so do not be neglectful in this regard.

عَنْ أَبِي أُمَامَةَ قَالَ: قِيلَ لِرَسُولِ اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: أَيُّ الدُّعَاءِ أَسْمَعُ؟ قَالَ: جَوْفُ اللَّيْلِ الْآخِرِ
وَدُبُرِ الصَّلَوَاتِ الْمَكْتُوباتِ،

Sayyidina Abu Umaamah Radhiyallaahu Anhu narrates that it was said to Rasulullah Sallallaahu Alayhi wa Sallam: "Which Du'aa is most heard (closest to acceptance)?" He said: "During the middle of the latter part of the night, and after the Fardh salaahs." (Tirmidhi)

The Du'aas in this booklet are recorded in Hadeeth, thus Sunnah to recite after the Fardh Salaah.

It is not necessary to recite all after the Salaah. Memorise them all, but recite one or two after a Salaah, and alternate between them. Do not lengthen the Du'aa after that Salaah which has Sunnah Salah after it. A lengthy Du'aa can be made after Fajr and Asr. Make a short Du'aa after Thuhr, Maghrib, and Eshaa, and thereafter perform the Sunnah Salaahs. A lengthy Du'aa can be made after completion of the Sunnah Salaahs.

After Salaam, Rasulullah Sallallaahu Alayhi wa Sallam recited

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ

Astaghfirullah
thrice and then the following Du'aa:

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ السَّلَامُ وَمِنْكَ السَّلَامُ، تَبَارَكْتَ يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ
وَالْإِكْرَامِ،

Allahumma antas salaam wa minkas salaam tabaarakta ya zal
jalaali wal ikraam

O Allah You are (the giver) of peace and from You is peace.
Blessed are You O Possessor of greatness and honour.

Sayyidina Mu'aadh bin Jabal Radhiyallaahu Anhu narrates an Istighfaar to be recited thrice after Salaah:

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ الَّذِي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ وَأَتُوبُ
إِلَيْهِ،

Astaghfirullah allazi laa ilaha illa huwal hayyul qayyum wa a tooboo ilaih

I seek the forgiveness of Allah who is (that Being) that there is no god besides Him. He is the living and the self subsistent, and I repent unto him.

This Du'aa is narrated from Sayyidina Mugheerah bin Shu'bah Radhiyallaahu Anhu:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ
الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ، اللَّهُمَّ لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا
أَعْطَيْتَ وَلَا مُعْطِيَ لِمَا مَنَعْتَ وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا الْجَدِّ مِنْكَ
الْجَدُّ،

La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la shareeka lahu lahul mulku wa lahul hamdu wa huwa ala kulli shayin qadeer. Allahumma la maania lima a'tayata wa la mutiya lima mana'ta wa la yanfa oo zal jaddi minkal jadd

There is none worthy of worship besides Allah, who is alone, and he has no partner. His is the kingdom and for him is all praise, and he has power over everything. O Allah none can prevent what you have willed to give, and none can give what you have willed to withhold, and the influence of an influential person is of no benefit against you.

Sayyidah Ummi Salamah Radhiyallaahu Anhaa narrates the following Du'aa after Salaah:

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ رِزْقًا طَيِّبًا، وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا، وَعِلْمًا
نَافِعًا،

*Allahumma inni us aluka rizqan tayyiban wa amalam
mutaqabbalan wa ilman naafian*

O Allah, I ask from you pure (Halaal) sustenance, accepted actions (accepted by You), and beneficial knowledge.

The Du'aa of Nabi Dawood Alayhis Salaam after Salaah, also recited by Rasulullah Sallallaahu Alayhi wa Sallam:

اللَّهُمَّ أَصْلِحْ لِي دِينِي الَّذِي جَعَلْتَهُ لِي عِصْمَةً وَأَصْلِحْ لِي دُنْيَايَ الَّتِي
جَعَلْتَ فِيهَا مَعَاشِي، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِرِضَاكَ مِنْ سَخَطِكَ، وَأَعُوذُ بِعَفْوِكَ
مِنْ نِقْمَتِكَ، وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْكَ، لَا مَانِعَ لِمَا أَعْطَيْتَ وَلَا مُعْطِيَ لِمَا
مَنْعْتَ وَلَا يَنْفَعُ ذَا الْجَدِّ مِنْكَ الْجَدُّ

*Allahumma aslih lee deeniyal lazi ja altahu lee ismataw wa aslih lee dunyaa
yal lati ja alta feeha ma aashi. Allahumma inni a oozoo bi ridaaka min
sakhatik wa a oozoo bi afwika min niqmatik wa a oozoo bika minka. La
maania lima a'tayata wa la mutiya lima mana'ta wa la yanfa oo zal jaddi
minkal jadd*

O Allah, rectify for me my religion (deen) which You have made for me a protection. And rectify for me my worldly affairs in which You have made my sustenance. O Allah, I seek refuge through Your pleasure from Your displeasure. And I seek your refuge through Your pardon from Your anger, and I seek refuge in You from You. None can prevent what You have willed to give, and none can give what You have willed to withhold, and the influence of an influential person is of no benefit against You.

The recital of Tasbeeh Fatimah is also encouraged. It should be recited after the Fardh of Fajr and Asr, and after the Sunnahs of Thuhr, Maghrib, and Eshaa.

33 times *Subhaanallah* سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ

33 times *Alhamdulillah* الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ

33 times *Allaahu akbar* اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ

Thereafter recite once:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ
وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ،

*La ilaaha illallahu wahdahu la shareeka lahu la hul mulku wa la hul
hamdu wa huwa ala kulli shayin qadeer*

There is none worthy of worship besides Allah, who is alone, and He has no partner. His is the kingdom and for Him is all praise, and He has power over everything.

Rasulullah Sallallaahu Alayhi wa Sallam would rub his right hand on his forehead after completing his Salaah and would recite a Du'aa. This Du'aa is to remove grief and sorrow.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الرَّحْمَنُ الرَّحِيمُ، اللَّهُمَّ
أَذْهِبْ عَنِّي الْهَمَّ وَالْحُزْنَ،

*Bismillahil lazi la ilaha illa huwar rahmaanur rahim. Allahumma
azhib annil hamma wal huzn.*

In the name of Allah with whom there is no god but Him, He is the beneficent and the merciful. O Allah, remove from me worry and grief.
